

**FEE SCHEDULE FOR USE OF FACILITIES
(OTHER THAN FOR WEDDINGS)

<u>Facility/Space</u>	<u>Fee Charged</u>
Sanctuary - 3 hours or less	\$ 100
Sanctuary more than 3 hours	\$ 100 + \$30 per hr over 3 hrs. (prorated)
Seekers Classroom	\$ 50
Small Fellowship Hall	\$ 50
Classrooms, each	\$ 20
Social Hall - only	\$150 + \$30 per hr over 3 hrs.(prorated)
Social Hall & Kitchen	\$250 + \$60 per hr over 3 hrs.(prorated)

Fee schedule applies as follows:

- Business - for-profit, and non-TUMC member personal use : All fees apply.
- Community service organizations - Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, AA, Lions Club, Kiwanis, Alanon, Alzheimer's, etc.: donations accepted and appreciated to offset cost of utilities.
- United Methodist, but non-TUMC, affiliated organizations such as District Training & District UMM: donations requested, accepted and appreciated to offset cost of utilities.
- TUMC Affiliated groups and activities. i.e., Sunday Schools, UMW, UMM, etc.: no Fee required.
- TUMC Members -Free use of above facilities by TUMC members will be granted on a case-by-case basis, depending upon the occasion and other circumstances.

Note: The provisions of the Social Hall & Kitchen Usage Procedures document, provided separately, must be followed in their entirety to ensure the safe, effective, and economical operation of the facilities and user personnel.

CLEAN-UP/DAMAGE DEPOSIT

In addition to the foregoing, a Clean-up/Damage Deposit will be required upon scheduling the Social Hall, and/or Kitchen and will be refunded within one week, if the facilities are in same degree of cleanliness and material condition as before the event began.

- For non-TUMC affiliated Group/Activity \$75 Deposit
- For TUMC Affiliated Group/Activity or member - No Deposit

The Trustees expect that users of our facilities will respect and use them as they would their own property. We also expect that users will take care to leave the facilities in a clean and orderly state upon completion of any scheduled event, as stated in the use policies which were distributed to all groups using the facility.

If however, the facilities are not cleaned appropriately, and no deposit was collected, custodial fees will be billed to the responsible party. If the facilities are left in an unacceptable state, permission to use the facilities for subsequent events may be denied.

If assistance is needed to set up for the event or to clean up after the event, you may contact the custodians at the church for their assistance. A custodial fee is expected, appropriate to the amount of work required. This is above the other fees charged. Custodial equipment can be obtained to help facilitate cleaning in the closet through the stairwell doors closest to the kitchen.
